Murray Irrigation opens doors at single Finley site

Murray Irrigation Limited has opened its doors in a newly constructed, purpose-designed building at a single site in Finley.

The Murray Irrigation Limited office, the Murray Irrigation works depot, and the Murray Irrigation precast concrete business MILCast now operate from the same location on the corner of Murray Hut Drive and Murray Street in Finley.

Murray Irrigation General Manager Anthony Couroupis said the company's Board of Directors had approved the consolidation to reduce costs, streamline Murray Irrigation's Finley operations, and to take advantage of business opportunities.

"The consolidation offers our customers the convenience of visiting a single location in Finley, regardless of the Murray Irrigation service they require, and the modern building is well designed to meet the requirements of all our customers and staff," Mr Couroupis said.

He added that all telephone numbers for Murray Irrigation and its staff in Finley remain unchanged, and that customers were encouraged to visit the new office.

Access to the new office is via Murray Hut Drive. Landscaping of the new site will see removal of the outer fencing and new signage in the near future.

Murray Irrigation formerly operated from two sites in the Finley township - Murray Street, where the Finley office of Murray Irrigation was located, and Murray Hut Drive, where the works depot and MILCast are located.

The former Murray Irrigation office in Murray Street has been purchased by Berrigan Shire Council.

The new building will be officially opened in the coming months.
