Increase in Class C (General Security) allocation of one percent

Murray Irrigation this morning announced an increase in Class C (General Security) allocation of one percent to 20 percent.

This improvement in water availability follows the announcement by the NSW Office of Water (NOW) earlier today.

The one percent increase has been attributed to improvement in water availability in the Murray catchment due to recent rainfall over New South Wales.
