## Drought Support Workers

The following information is general in nature and although we have provided some figures, **please don't self assess**.

Take the time to speak with the **agency** concerned, a **Drought Support Worker**, or a **Rural Financial Counsellor**.

Drought Support Workers provide support for families during drought and other emergencies, such as floods, fires and storms. This often involves supplying information on what support and assistance is available and who may be eligible, along with help in filling out the multitude of forms. Drought Support Workers can also provide personal support to people who just want to talk. This can involve talking to farmers and their families on the phone, visiting on their farms or talking to small groups of neighbours.

A significant aspect of the work is development within rural communities to help maintain social bonds and community ties that may be stretched due to the stresses that many people are under. The co-ordination of Farm Family Gatherings helps to bring people together and overcome the isolation that stress and depression can cause.
