## Accounts due

Accounts were mailed to Murray Irrigation customers on Wednesday 18 January. All invoices are due by 5pm Friday 17 February. To be eligible for the 10 percent discount, all accounts must be paid before this date.

## Customer meetings

Murray Irrigation will hold customer meetings starting Wednesday 8 February to discuss a number of issues including PIOP, the Network Consultation Paper, outlet and meter strategy, remote-control pilot project, the current water ordering system and Distribution Rules policy, and the Murray-Darling Basin Plan. ## Round 2 On-Farm Irrigation Efficiency Program update

The Department of Sustainability, Environment, Water, Populations and Communities (SEWPaC) is continuing to finalise its assessment of Round 2 applications. Murray Irrigation is hopeful that a funding agreement with SEWPaC can be finalised in February. Participating landholders will be notified in writing once Murray Irrigation is able to issue Landholder Works Contracts.

## Low water account balances

A significant number of customers have had their outlets finished by Murray Irrigation due to low water account balances. In most cases Water Distribution staff attempt to contact customers prior to action being taken, however in some cases, contact has been made several times, and inadequate volumes of water have been transferred to an account, causing the outlet to be finished. Customers are reminded to ensure they consider their crop requirements carefully and ensure that adequate water is transferred to prevent the action occurring again. In many cases customers may experience a four-day wait to have outlets restarted.

## Delivery entitlements information

Murray Irrigation customers are reminded they can access their delivery entitlements information by logging on to Murray Irrigation's website, in the *Customer* section. Customers can access their individual delivery entitlements figures including annual trade, casual usage fee threshold, volumes available to transfer and more at just the click of a button. Next Tuesday 31 January, annual transfers from the Murrumbidgee Valley to the Murray Valley will close, as the rules within the Murrumbidgee Water Sharing Plan state that intervalley annual transfers must close at the end of January.
