## Resource distribution and winter shutdown

Murray Irrigation will issue a five percent resource distribution to its customers.

The distribution will be made available to delivery entitlement holders who have paid all outstanding accounts up to and including the September quarter by 5.00pm Monday 8 January.

This distribution brings the total to eight percent for the 2017/18 irrigation season.

Murray Irrigation CEO Michael Renehan said the allocation reflects the company's delivery performance, which continues to improve year on year.

"An improvement in rainfall and the likelihood of favourable allocation announcements for the remainder of this season and the next have also made the resource distribution possible," Mr Renehan said.

### Winter shut down deferred until 1 May

The planned shutdown of the Mulwala Canal offtake has now been deferred until Tuesday 1 May. The board made the decision to defer the closure by a week following feedback received from a number of customers who feared they would be adversely affected.

The early closure is to allow for a major upgrade of structures along the Mulwala Canal. This work, which will involve over 200 contractors, is part of the PIIOP 3 automation project and needs to be completed before June 2019.
