The app uses GPS functionality built into smart phones to help a Triple Zero (000) caller provide critical location details required to mobilise emergency services. PIIOP compliance audit

The Department of Agriculture and Water Resources recently engaged Ernst & Young (EY) to undertake a review of compliance with contractual obligations relevant to financial management of Murray Irrigation's Private Irrigation Infrastructure Operators Program (PIIOP Rounds 2 and 3). The review identified that Murray Irrigation is compliant with 37 of 38 of its contractual obligations relevant to financial management under each of the funding agreements. An opportunity to enhance Murray Irrigation's oversight of proponents was identified.
