

Guide to the application: Disconnection

Disconnection refers to the process where a customer wishes to cease having their landholding being supplied by Murray Irrigation, completely removing all connection to the supply system and selling or otherwise disposing of all shares, water entitlements and delivery entitlements.

Separate applications disposing of all shares, water entitlements and delivery entitlements held must be lodged with this application. The land disconnected will not be removed from the company's area of operations, except in special circumstances considered on a case by case basis.

The removal of outlets, whilst retaining connection to the system, is a different process. For information on this please consult Operations.

1 Checklist

The following is a list of documentation required for processing of this application:

1.1 Submission for conditional approval:

- Form 32, completed by the owner of the land
- Current title searches
- Forms for transfer or cancellation of shares and entitlements (refer Forms 9 or 14)

1.2 Required for registration:

- Original Share / Water Entitlements / Delivery Entitlements Certificates
- Payment of disconnection fees for each point of supply removed. (currently waived)
- Payment of account – all amounts

Additional requirements, if any, will be advised when conditional approval is granted.

Applications received in order are considered for conditional approval weekly. Documentation should be submitted in a single parcel.

2 General notes

- 1) All shares, water entitlements and delivery entitlements held in connection with the landholding must also be disposed of or otherwise dealt with, to reduce the number of each held in connection with the landholding to zero.
- 2) All water allocation in the in water account held in connection with the landholding must also be disposed of or otherwise dealt with to reduce the balance to zero.
- 3) The act of disconnection is generally permanent and final. **No** water may be supplied to the disconnected land from Murray Irrigation's channel system – to do otherwise may be an offence under the *Water Management Act 2000* (NSW), subject to maximum penalties exceeding \$200,000.
- 4) The lands disconnected will not be removed from the company's area of operations, except in special circumstances considered on a case by case basis.
- 5) Fencing of any infrastructure crossing the disconnected lands may be required at the customer's cost, subject to the Entitlements Contract.
- 6) Shares may be transferred to another landholder or cancelled (see form 14).
- 7) Water entitlements may be transferred to another account (whether owned by the customer or not).
- 8) Delivery entitlements may be transferred or terminated (see form 14).
- 9) If wishing to simply remove a single outlet, but retain connection to the system, please instead consult Operations regarding an application for landholder works.
- 10) **Forms or pages that are not dated or otherwise complete may be returned.**

3 Completing the application

- 1) Only current version forms will be accepted.
- 2) Type into interactive forms prior to printing/ all handwriting should be in BLOCK letters in blue or black ink.
- 3) All spaces on the form must be completed and any corrections initialled.
- 4) The application must be executed by ALL registered proprietors. If executing as attorney, please make note of the power of attorney.
- 5) Do not submit this guide with the application.
