Water Entitlements rebate

Murray Irrigation continues to push WaterNSW for a resolution to delivering proposed drought rebates for fixed fees against Water Entitlements. A response from WaterNSW is expected within the next three weeks which will confirm the rebate amount and any terms associated with this package. Murray Irrigation will pass details onto customers as soon as a response has been received.

October climatic summary

The Bureau of Meteorology reports that the area averaged rainfall for the Murray-Darling Basin in October was 36.6mm. This is nine percent below the long-term average for the month of October.

River Murray system inflows for October totalled 318GL - well below the long-term median of 973GL. In comparison with the historical record since 1891, only nine percent of monthly totals for October have been lower than the inflows observed last month. For further details, click [here](#).
