- Ensure that all employees, suppliers and contractors know their health and safety responsibilities.
- Report and investigate all incidents and implement corrective actions to prevent reoccurrences.
- Ensure health surveillance is performed in accordance with legislative requirements.
- Audit, inspect and review our workplaces and WHS systems to identify areas for continuous improvement.
- Hold all employees, management and executives accountable for the correct execution of safety processes.

To develop a strong safety culture, Murray Irrigation will:

- Support individuals stopping work when unsafe conditions are present.
- Encourage the reporting of hazards, incidents and health and safety initiatives.
- Reward positive safety performance.
