



Shareholder Director elections

If more than three nominations are received an election via postal ballot will be held. Appointments will be for a four-year term from the conclusion of the 2019 Annual General Meeting.

Written nominations must be lodged with Murray Irrigation's Returning Officer by **5.00pm AEST Friday 30 August 2019** and it is critical to note that nominations received after that deadline will not be considered. The address for lodgement of nominations is provided on the nomination form.
