



Water Entitlement Rebate

We have received confirmation from WaterNSW that the rebate on fixed fees for Water Entitlements will be extended into this season.

The terms are a rebate of the fixed fee component of Water Entitlements capped at \$1,000 per landholding, per quarter.

When eligible customers receive their September 2019 Quarter Invoice, the "balance brought forward" section will include the rebates for the current quarter and the June 2019 quarter.
