Water has been retained in areas not closed for maintenance as a part of the new mode of winter operations.

This water is available for delivery to customers.

Murray Irrigation's Fees and Prices

Murray Irrigation's Board has approved an increase to the company's fees and prices, which will come into effect on 1 July 2020.

The increase of 2.2% is in-line with the Consumer Price Index (CPI).

Our cost reduction efforts earlier in the season resulted in us being able to apply only a marginal increase, while still allowing us to provide our current level of service.

The revised Fees and Prices Schedule will soon be sent to customers, in-line with our compliance requirements.

Customer Briefings

Murray Irrigation will this month launch a new online customer briefing.

The new format allows customers to filter the content and listen at a time that suits them, and allows us to deliver our operational update during the current pandemic.

The briefing will update you on the 2019/20 irrigation season, Murray Irrigation's strategic activities and an outlook for the 2020/21 season.

Water allocation account balances

Customers should consider their allocation accounts prior to the end of the season.

Carryover is capped at 50 percent of Class C water entitlements held, and any volume exceeding this will be forfeited at the end of the season.

Once that allocation account reaches its limit of 110% (carryover + allocation) in 2020/21, no additional water is allocated to that account.

E.g. if you carryover 40%, any allocation exceeding 70% will not be received.
