## Winter Operations

As part of the new Winter Operations, water is available for delivery in those areas that are not closed for maintenance.

## Water allocation account balances

Customers have until midnight, Wednesday, 24 June to undertake online internal transfers on their water allocation account through the customer portal.

Customers need to be aware that carryover is capped at 50 percent of Class C water entitlements held, and any volume exceeding this will be forfeited at the end of the season.

Once that allocation account reaches its limit of 110% (carryover + allocation) in 2020/21, no additional water is allocated to that account.

E.g. If you carryover 40%, any allocation exceeding 70% will not be received.
