



## Allocation Announcement

The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) last week announced a two percent allocation for General Security water entitlements.

This, along with the Supplementary Water event and products from our WaterWell suite, will provide irrigators with increased certainty when planning for the season.

## Supplementary Water not extended

DPIE has advised that there will not be an extension to the recent supplementary water event.

The supplementary event in the Mulwala system finished at 8am yesterday, 21 July 2020, however Murray Irrigation slightly extended customer orders with outlets finishing in the evening.

Murray Irrigation continues to process orders for those customers who access water from the Wakool offtake, who placed an Expression of Interest.

Please note that the Wakool system is currently restricted to 1100ML/day and flows are also restricted at 5ML per flow share.

## Water Operations 2020/21 season

Water delivery will be in line with our [2020/21 Season Operating Plan](#) with operations commencing in Mode One.

This includes

- channels operated only where orders are placed
- six-day advance notice required for orders
- online ordering system will automatically offer 144 hours (six days) in advance
- orders reviewed daily with customers contacted if water can be delivered earlier than six days

- customers should call Customer Operations to arrange stock and domestic supply.

## Online water ordering reopens

The online water ordering system has now reopened for customer orders.

These will be reviewed daily, in-line with Operating Mode One and customers notified when orders can be delivered.

## Completion of Winter Works

Murray Irrigation's winter works will finish this week.

Inspections last winter identified several public bridges in which repairs were critical and could not be deferred beyond this season.

Winter Works have ensured that these bridges did not fail and removed the severe safety risk to road and other users.

Murray Irrigation will complete the remaining works as scheduled, to ensure the system is fit for purpose for the season.
