



Saving the Southern Bell Frog!

We're asking for your help to monitor the threatened southern bell frog.

One of the building blocks of managing threatened species is understanding where and when they occur.

We're asking for your help to monitor this iconic frog.

All you need to do is download the Australian Museums' FrogID mobile phone app (works on iOS and Android), join the "Southern Bell Frog Champions" group and use FrogID to record frog calls wherever you go.

You don't have to identify the calls yourself, although you're welcome to! Once recorded with the FrogID app, you can upload your frog calls. Frog experts identify all calls that are submitted and send you an email letting you know what you have found. Records of the southern bell frog are sent back to DPIE (Helen Waudby, helen.waudby@environment.nsw.gov.au) to help with planning and management.

To help, all you need to do is:

- *Download the FrogID app onto your phone*
- *On a computer, create a FrogID account at <https://www.frogid.net.au/signup>*
- *Join the Southern Bell Frog Champions group (under 'My group' in your FrogID profile)*
- *Start recording frogs wherever you go!*

We'll keep you updated on how many frog calls are being uploaded and what species are being identified.
