## Murray Irrigation 2020 AGM

### What you need to know:

**When:** 10:30am, Wednesday, 25 November 2020

**Where:** Online

#### • **AGM voting**

Votes can be made prior to the AGM, without the need to appoint a proxy.

These direct votes close at 10.30am, on Monday, 23 November 2020.

To be eligible to vote at the AGM, a shareholder must have paid all fees presently due and payable to the company by 10.30am on Sunday, 22 November 2020 (that is, at least 72 hours before the meeting). This refers to charges up to, and including, the June 2020 quarter four invoice.

Please allow sufficient time for payments to clear by this deadline.

#### • **Asking questions at the AGM**

There will be an opportunity for shareholders to ask questions during the AGM, via the online meeting platform.

#### • **Appointing a proxy**

Proxies must be appointed by 10.30am on Monday, 23 November 2020.

Shareholders can appoint a proxy to attend the AGM and vote on their behalf. Proxies can be appointed online or by completing and submitting the voting form provided with your Notice of Meeting.

Your proxy may be an individual or a body corporate and does not need to be a shareholder.
