



## General Security Water Allocation

The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) yesterday, announced **no increase** for General Security water entitlements in the NSW Murray zone, however the announcement included information regarding payback of the Barmah-Millewa Allowance and special accounting arrangements with South Australia.

## End of season Carryover

Customers should consider their allocation accounts prior to the end of the season.

Carryover is capped at 50 percent of Class C water entitlements held, and any volume exceeding this will be forfeited at the end of the season.

Once that allocation account reaches its limit of 110% (carryover + allocation) in 2021/22, no additional water is allocated to that account.

E.g. if you carryover 40%, any allocation exceeding 70% will not be received.



## Landholder funded works

Requests for landholder funded works need to be submitted by COB Thursday, 1 April 2021, to be considered for completion during the winter maintenance period.
