## Water delivery through Winter Operating Mode

Customers can continue to access water deliveries in zones where maintenance is not occurring.

The water ordering system will automatically offer customers 96 hours (four days) in advance for all orders through the Winter Operating period.

Orders will be reviewed daily to determine our capacity to supply them.

All customers requesting water will be notified of the outcome of the review, and if their order can or cannot be delivered.

Please remember that supply is not guaranteed throughout Winter Operating Mode.

## WEX closure dates for trade

Key dates for the closure of internal and external trades for the 2020/2021 season.

- 5.00pm Wednesday, 23 June 2021 – closure of Water Exchange
- 5.00pm Friday, 25 June 2021 – closure of external transfers to/from Murray Irrigation
- 11.59pm Sunday, 27 June 2021 – closure of internal annual transfers and access to water accounts through the customer portal

- 9.00am Thursday, 1 July 2021 – reopening of Water Exchange and customer water accounts.

## End of season Carryover

Customers should consider their allocation accounts prior to the end of the season.

Carryover is capped at 50 percent of Class C water entitlements held, and any volume exceeding this will be forfeited at the end of the season.

Once that allocation account reaches its limit of 110% (carryover + allocation) in 2021/22, no additional water is allocated to that account.

E.g. if you carryover 40%, any allocation exceeding 70% will not be received.
