



## Bridge Works – slow down to 40km/h

Murray Irrigation bridge works are underway around the footprint.

Drivers are urged to slow down and obey all traffic control measures to ensure the safety of road users, staff and contractors.

## Deliveries in non-maintenance zones

Water deliveries during Winter Operating Mode are continuing with more than 5,000 ML delivered to customers in areas that are not closed for maintenance, since Saturday, 15 May 2021.

The Wakool offtake is still in operation and yesterday, Monday 24 May 2021, is delivering 280 ML to customers.
