End of season Carryover

Some Murray Irrigation customers are at risk of forfeiting water at the closure of the 2020/21 season.

SMS messages have been sent to impacted customers, who should consider their allocation accounts prior to the end of the season.

Carryover is capped at 50 percent of Class C water entitlements held, and any volume exceeding this will be forfeited at the end of the season.



Foreign ownership of land and water

Foreign residents who own agricultural land and certain water rights are required to register these rights with the Australian Taxation Office (ATO).

In accordance with Murray Irrigation's Constitution (Rule 116) members must also give notice to the Company if they are, become or cease to be a foreign person during a financial year (1 July to 30 June).

A person, or entity, is classified as 'foreign' if they are not an Australian resident for tax purposes. Full details are on the ATO's [website](#).
