## WEX Closure dates for trade

The closure of internal and external trades for the 2020/2021 season is fast approaching:

- 5.00pm Wednesday, 23 June 2021 – closure of Water Exchange
- 5.00pm Friday, 25 June 2021 – closure of external transfers to/from Murray Irrigation
- 11.59pm Sunday, 27 June 2021 – closure of internal annual transfers and access to water accounts through the Customer Portal
- 9.00am Thursday, 1 July 2021 – reopening of Water Exchange and customer water accounts.

## End of season Carryover

Customers should consider their allocation accounts prior to the end of the season.

Carryover is capped at 50 percent of Class C Water Entitlements held, and any volume exceeding this will be forfeited at the end of the season.

Once that allocation account reaches its limit of 110% in 2021/22, no additional water is allocated to that account.

E.g. if you carryover 40%, any allocation exceeding 70% will not be received.
