WEX Closure dates for trade

- 5.00pm **Tomorrow**, 23 June 2021 – closure of Water Exchange
- 5.00pm **Friday**, 25 June 2021 – closure of external transfers to/from Murray Irrigation
- 11.59pm **Sunday**, 27 June 2021 – closure of internal annual transfers and access to water accounts through the Customer Portal

The Water Exchange will re-open at 9.00am on Thursday, 1 July 2021 for external and internal annual transfers.

Winter Operating Mode

The Mulwala offtake reopened today to commence partially refilling the Mulwala system.

Adequate airspace will be retained in the short term to balance the benefit of any potential supplementary events against the ability to respond to customer orders.

The [2021 Winter Operations program](#) remains on schedule for completion in the next six weeks, with over a quarter of our scheduled work orders completed.

Customer can continue to access water orders over the winter period however, they are reminded that supply is not guaranteed.

End of season Carryover

Carryover is capped at 50 percent of Class C Water Entitlements held, and any volume exceeding this will be forfeited at the end of the season.

Once that allocation account reaches its limit of 110% in 2021/22, no additional water is allocated to that account.

E.g. if you carryover 40%, any allocation exceeding 70% will not be received.



Customer Service Privacy

We're required to do this by law, even if we're familiar with you.

Some questions may include:

- Landholder's name
- address and contact details
- other account details.

Note: Under the Privacy legislation, it is an offence to disclose information to any party other than the registered owner.
