Operating Mode

Customer Operations has completed the transition out of Winter Operations and will commence Regular Operations under Mode Three – Normal.

What does Mode Three mean for customers?

- Channels operated at full supply height where orders are placed, or future orders are known
- Water orders delivered within 1 day (subject to the 4 day advance constraints)
- Online ordering system will automatically offer the next available time

Why do we have Modes of Operation?

The different modes of operation are used to balance customer ordering flexibility with water saving initiatives.
