## Supplementary water deliveries finish

Deliveries of supplementary water finished this morning at normal outlet operating times. As notified last Friday Murray Irrigation's Supplementary licence of 121,704 units has been fully utilised.

All customers have been notified through email and SMS and have been advised that operating orders will convert to allocation water and be debited from customer's accounts. Murray Irrigation will continue to divert water under the UCF rule to maximise the opportunity while remaining within the allocation limit constraints of our bulk licence.

Further information of how this benefit can be passed on to customers will be communicated at a later date.

## IPART – Government Fees & Charges

Last week, The Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART) released its final determination outlining Water NSW's rural bulk water prices. These are identified as "government pass-through charges" and are charged against Water Entitlements and water usage.
