Potential Restrictions

Murray Irrigation customers are gearing up for an extremely busy year, with our recent Irrigation Intentions Survey showing a large summer irrigation program ahead.

The high demand may lead to delivery constraints during peak periods.

This may result in restrictions being applied to water orders based on flow shares.

Potential 'hot spot' areas for restrictions have been identified where customers have registered their irrigation intentions, and they have been notified of the potential impacts.

If you haven't already registered your irrigation intentions or have concerns about your supply please call Customer Operations.

Allocation Update

The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) announced an 11 percent increase to General Security allocation on Friday, 01 October 2021. This brings the total allocation to 55 percent.

Maximum Allocation limits

With the recent allocation increases, some of our customers have reached the 110% maximum allocation limit of their Water Entitlements.

Once an allocation account reaches its limit of 110% (carryover + allocation + Allocation Advance) they can receive no further allocation increases and no more water is allocated to the customer's account.
