



Irrigation Intentions Survey

Last season Murray Irrigation delivered over 300,000ML between February and May. With 110% allocation we are expecting a very large autumn program. We will be contacting customers shortly to ask about their watering intentions for this period. This will allow us to plan for any potential restrictions and proactively work with customers to deliver water and prepare for the upcoming Winter Works Program.

Please start to consider your Autumn irrigation plans including outlets, crop type, area and flow rates.

Asset Rationalisation Project

Murray Irrigation will continue to work with customers and remove redundant infrastructure in the field.

The initiative aims to reduce further capital expenditure while supporting on farm water use.

In 2021 we were able to negotiate with customers to remove over \$500K worth of underutilised assets from across the Murray Irrigation footprint.
