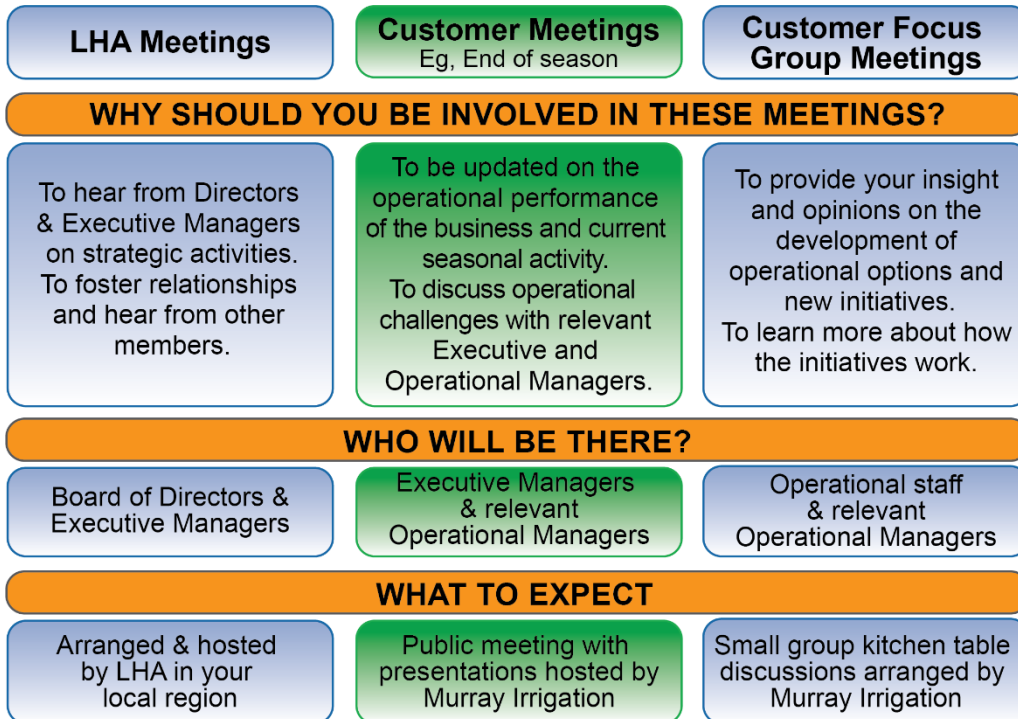




Meeting types and how you can be involved
