



Winter operations transition commences

Today we begin our transition into winter operations as communicated last week.

Water Orders

- 4-day advance notice will be automatically applied to all water delivery orders
- Where you require an earlier start, please send a message through the customer portal with your requested start date and time
- All orders will be reviewed daily, and customers notified of start date and time

Maintenance work preparation

- Preparation work including clearing and grading for channel de-silting and import of materials has started in maintenance zones
- This will increase heavy machinery activity and vehicle movements in these areas
- Please be aware of any safety signage and adhere to any changed road conditions

Final week for water intentions

- The winter irrigation and crop intentions survey closes this week – please complete the survey [here](#). Thank you to the customers who have already provided their intentions. This information will help us plan and schedule the maintenance work.
- In maintenance zones where no intentions or orders exist, drawdown will begin sooner.

Guaranteed delivery dates for all areas can be found [here](#). Non-guaranteed supply will be available through Winter Operations to

customers outside the maintenance zones.

When we guarantee water delivery, it means that you will get the water you ordered within that timeframe, in accordance with the Distribution Rules.

Please note Lake Mulwala will be lowered 5 metres below operating level to control invasive water weed from 15 May limiting our capacity to divert water to replenish the network.

Land & Water Management Plan 2022

Topics include safety while working near the electricity network and electrical safety, emergency preparedness and response, and vehicle safety.

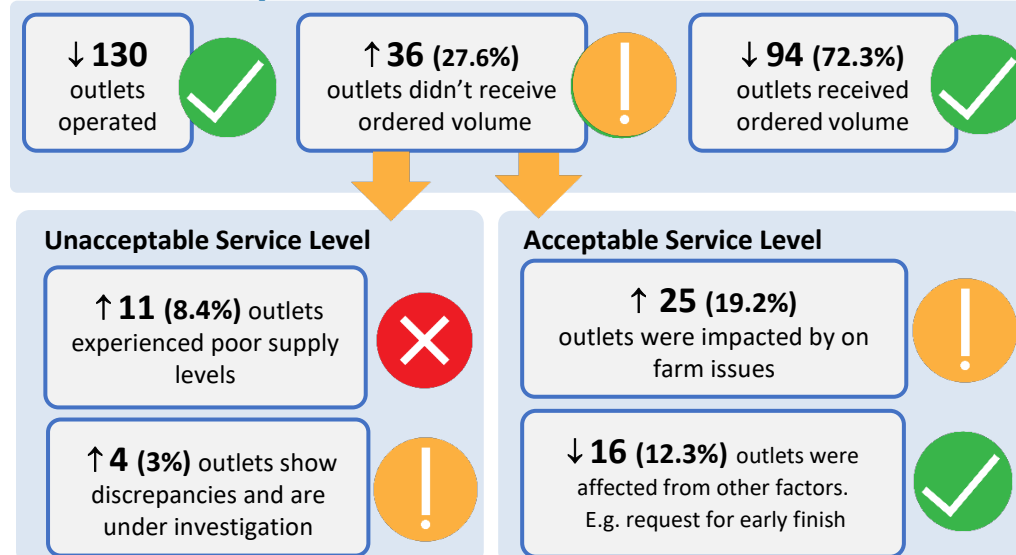
