



## Water Exchange Closure

Customers are reminded that Murray Irrigation's Water Exchange (WEX) will **close at 5pm this Wednesday 22 June**.

On closure of the Exchange, all unsold listings will return to customers' water allocation accounts.

## Carryover rules

The Water Sharing Plan (WSP) allows customers to carryover up to 50% of Class C water entitlements each season. Any volume exceeding this is forfeited at the end of the season.

Carryover also influences the amount of allocation a water account can receive in the subsequent season.

Under the WSP the maximum allocation a water account can receive in any season is 110% of the water entitlements held.

## Your water allocation account



As shown in the diagram above, carryover is added into the maximum allocation calculation.

For example, if you carryover 40%, any allocation exceeding 70% will not be received in the next season.

## Fees and Charges FY22-23

All customers were sent the [new Fees and Charges Schedules](#) on 16 July 2022.

Effective 1 July 2022, a 5.1% CPI increase will be applied, and an additional 7% increase to all fixed and variable fees and charges.

## 2022 Trade closure dates

**5.00pm Wednesday 22 June** – Water Exchange (WEX) closes

**5.00pm Friday 24 June** – external transfers to/from Murray Irrigation close

**5.00pm Monday 27 June** – internal transfers close and customer portal access closes.

## 2022-23 Trade & WEX opening

**7.00am Friday 1 July 2022** – re-opening of Water Exchange and customer portal where you can purchase, sell, and transfer online.

External and internal annual transfers also re-open on at 7am on Friday 1 July. **Note time change to 7am** to align with Water NSW opening hours.

## Indicative allocations for 2022-23

The Department of Planning and Environment released its final [Water Allocation Statement](#) on 16 May.

It noted indicative allocations on 1 July 2022 for 2022-23, "There is likely to be a commencing general security allocation of around 30% of entitlement."

The Department will make an opening Allocation Statement on Friday 1 July.
