



## Transition out of Winter Operations

Planning the transition out of Winter Operations into Regular Operations continues.

The Wakool offtake will begin diversions on 18 July. However, due to extensive weed control at Lake Mulwala, **diversions at the Mulwala offtake are delayed until 21 July.**

Filling Operational Areas serviced by the Mulwala offtake will be slower than normal to allow the lake to regain its operational level.

Murray Irrigation is working closely with WaterNSW and we will keep customers updated as more information becomes available.
