



## Transition out of Winter Operations

Refilling of the system has commenced using Murray Irrigation's supplementary licence.

- Filling channels to operating levels prior to announcing deliveries is critical to achieving appropriate channel control and avoiding safety and channel integrity incidents.
- Dam and river conditions, spring snow melt, and weather forecasts indicate a high likelihood of extended access to supplementary water
- Deliveries including supplementary access will be provided to customers once the majority of the systems are filled to operational levels.

**Customers in Non-Maintenance Zones:** Can place an order now via the [Customer Portal](#). Orders will be debited as allocated water and are not guaranteed until the triggers above are met.

**Customers in Maintenance Zones:** Will be notified by SMS when operational levels are achieved.

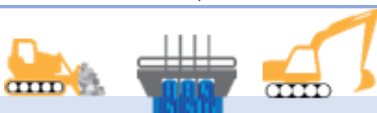
